#### **Packaging**

Ronafix Prebagged Render is supplied in 25kg packs. Ronabond Primer is supplied in 2kg and 10kg packs.

# **Application**

#### Preparation

Mechanically prepare the substrate to provide a structurally sound surface. Remove grease, oil, dirt and deleterious material.

Clean the surface with potable water.

#### **Priming**

Mix and apply Ronabond Primer.

#### Mixing

Mix components using a forced action mixer.

#### **Application**

Trowel apply the render on to the wet or tacky primer. Apply one coat for waterproofing, two coats for a watertight tanking render.

#### Curing

Cure with Monocure or tight fitting polythene.

# Shelf Life and Storage

Shelf life 9 months. Store in a cool dry place. Protect from frost.

#### **Health and Safety**

Ronafix Prebagged Render contains cement. Protective clothing such as goggles, overalls and gloves is recommended to prevent any effect from prolonged skin contact, inhalation or ingestion. Refer to Health and Safety Data Sheet.
